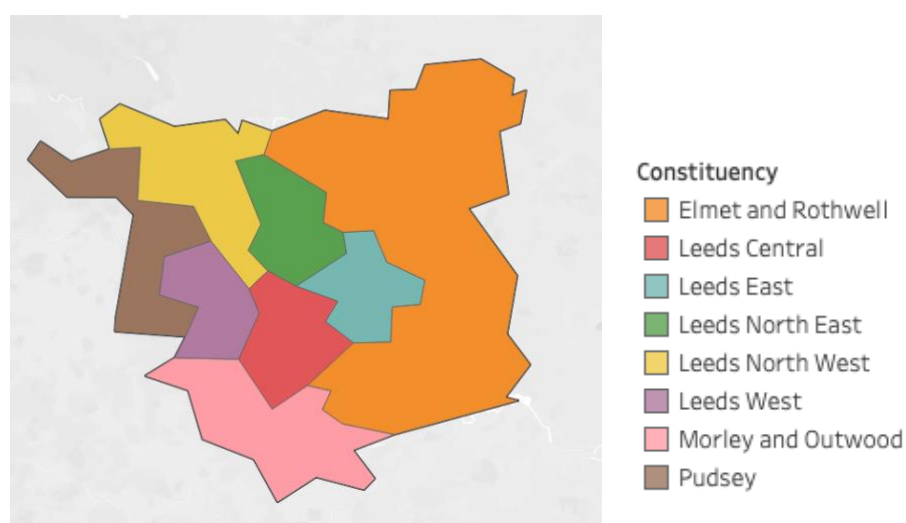


The National Lottery Community Fund

Investment in Leeds for the financial year ended 31 March 2019

As of Sept 2019, there were 247 active projects to the value of £44,485,857 in Leeds (this includes Awards for all, Reaching Communities & Partnerships & Strategic programmes)

In the last financial year, The National Lottery Community Fund (TNLCF) made 181 awards to 152 organisations and distributed £6.101.945 to communities across the city



Breakdown of investment by constituency (*Note that the data below only reflects the location of the registered organisation*)

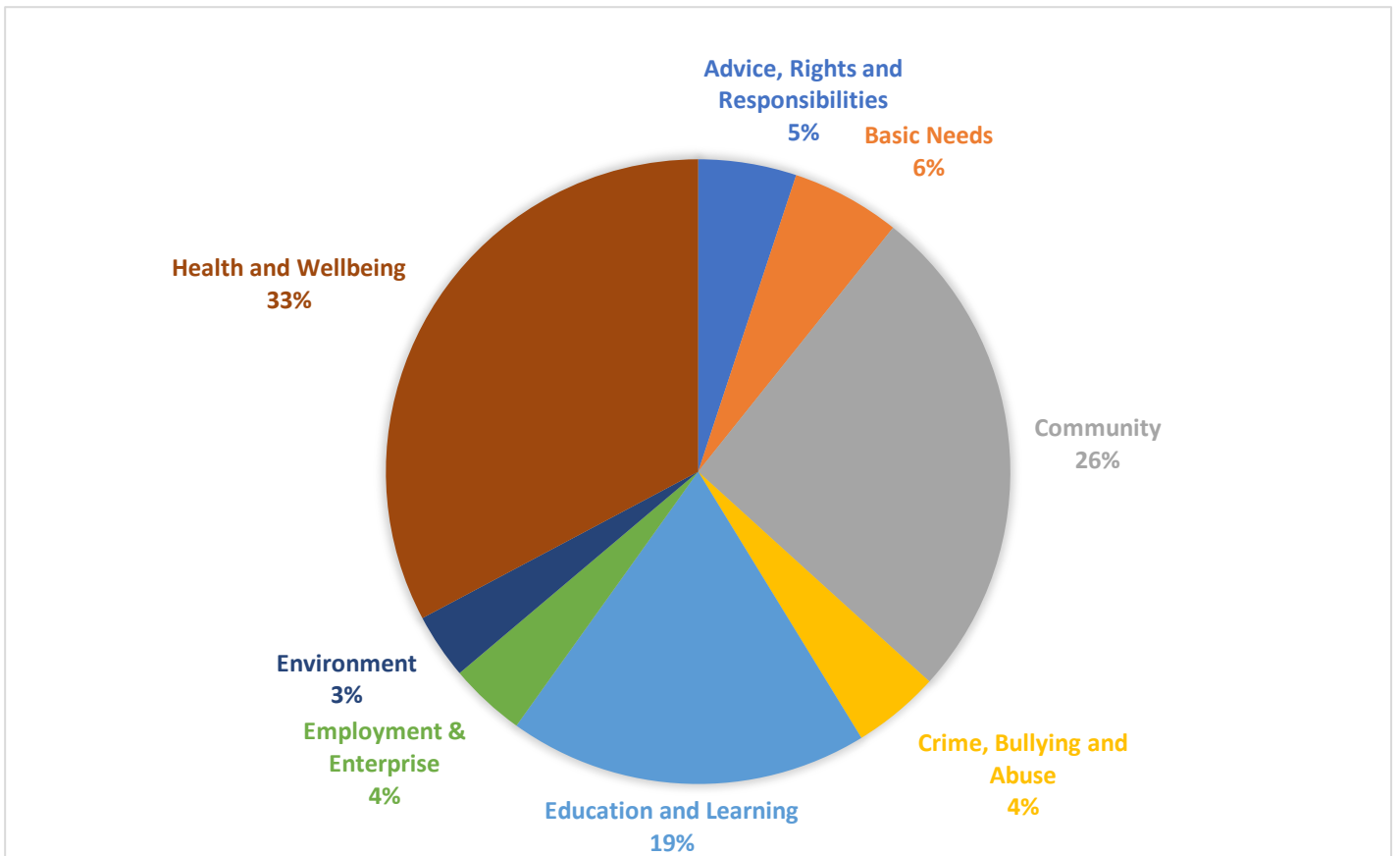
