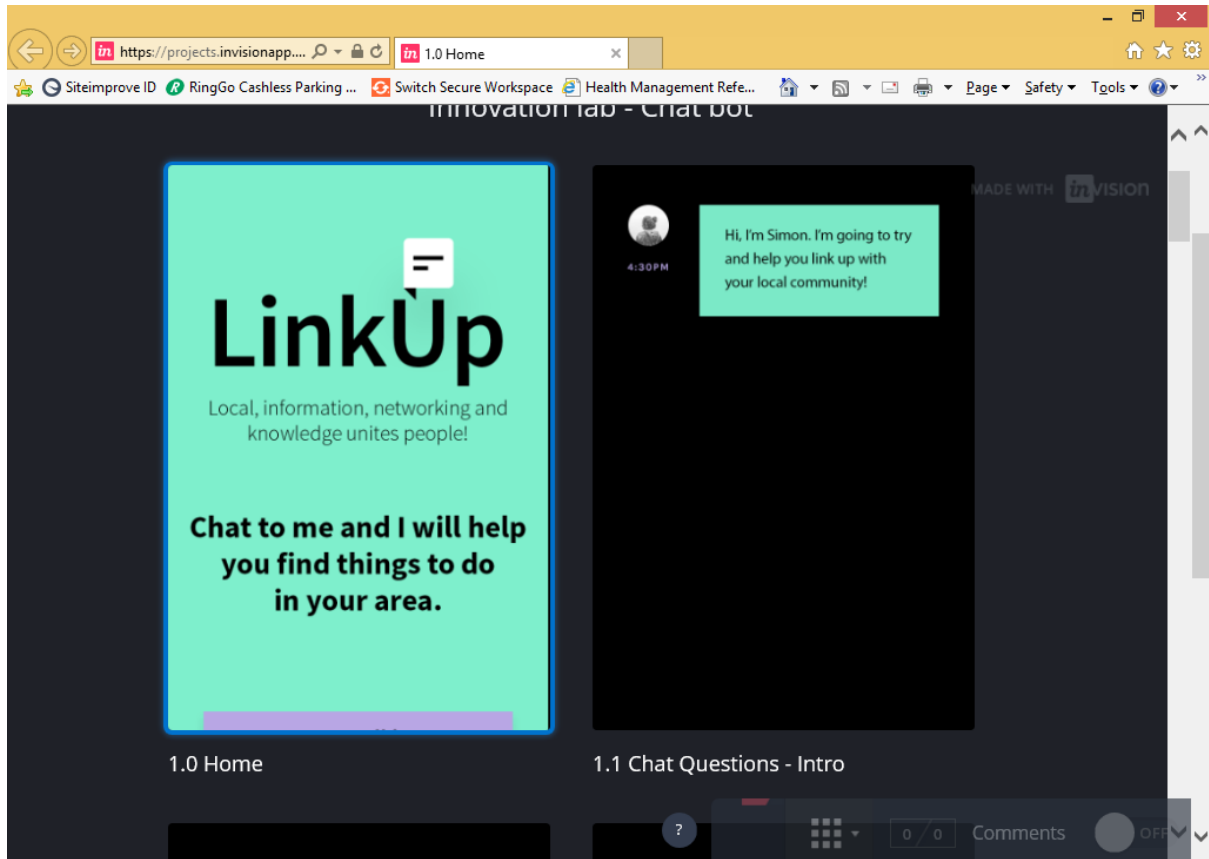

We narrowed down our audience to people who are socially isolated and living in poverty. We the point where isolated people have contact with others and narrowed it down to local shops and GP surgeries.</p> <p>The linkup assessment tool is a part of a wider project to enable older people with financial difficulties to access voluntary services and local groups. The proposed idea is a chat bot for older people that asks particular questions and pulls back relevant local community information and volunteers.</p> <p>Link to prototype: https://invis.io/9RBQGGINA</p> <p>A 2nd part of LinkUp is a tool for GPs and Adult care professionals to assess the needs of isolated and poor older people and link to relevant groups and volunteer groups.</p>

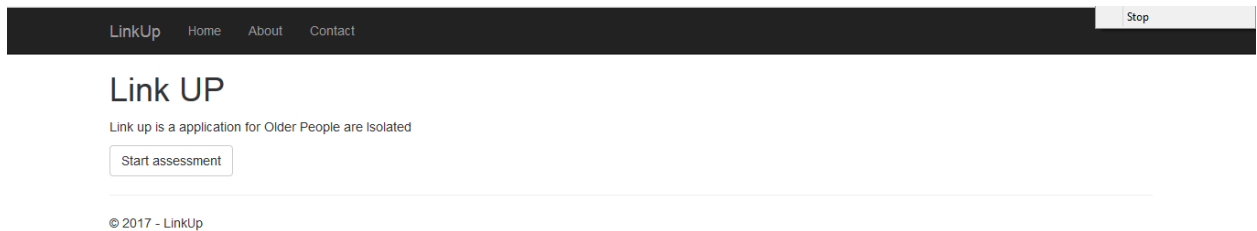
